CPC+ and Quality Submission Services

CPC+ Quality Submission Services (QSS)



- Virence will submit CPC+ quality measures directly to CMS on your behalf for CPC+ practices.
- Reporting Method: Electronic Health Record (EHR) reporting option.
- Submission data is bookmarked, a benefit that gives participants the ability to view CPC+ practice results historically, including patient lists associated with each measure.
- Confirmation of submission will be provided.





CPC+ Reporting Requirements

CPC+ eCQM Requirements



Measurement Period: CY2018 (January 1 – December 31, 2018)

Submission Options:

- Attestation
- Self-submit QRDA 3 file through the QPP website
- Virence will submit the data on behalf of an authorized CPC+ practice

Practice Site Level Reporting:

- All measures must be reported at the CPC+ practice site level.
- Include all patients (payers and the uninsured) who were seen one or more times at the practice site location during the calendar year (CY) measurement period by CPC+ clinicians (TIN/NPI)

Report eCQMs using the May 2017 version (all CQMs in CQR are at the required version)

CPC+ Reporting Requirements

Practices must successfully report 9 of the 19 measures from the CPC+ eCQM set

- 1. Report both Outcome measures
- 2. Report at least seven of the remaining 17 measures

CPC+ Quality Measure Selection

- 1. Every quality measure displayed in the dashboard will be submitted at authorization.
- 2. Selecting the six checkboxes applies to the estimated MIPS score only.
- 3. You can choose to
 - Submit all measures
 - You can be selective about the measures submitted to CMS by navigating to Configuration > Measurement Settings and selecting specific measures.
 Remember to recalculate after measure reconfiguration.

Reminder: A CPC+ practice QRDAIII downloaded for self-submission to CMS prior to the 1.6.7 release may contain obsolete measures and would be rejected at submission.

Preparing for CPC+ Authorization



What is Authorization?

- When the 'Authorize CPC+' button is selected, you are indicating your approval of the current measure selections and measurement periods for submission to CMS.
- All measures configured, measure scores and the measurement period chosen will be submitted to CMS.
 - Simple, and as fast as the click of a button, but authorization is final!
- CPC+ practice fees are assessed when the group practice is created and includes the build, configuration, on-demand calculations and submission of the CPC Plus Group practice data. Fees are assessed regardless of submission.



Authorization Dates: Friday January 11th – Friday February 15th

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CPC+ in the MIPS Dashboard

The CPC+ practice displays in the MIPS dashboard but MIPS scoring is **not** applicable to a CPC+ practice including:

- MIPS estimated final score
- MIPS Quality Score Breakdown
- Six measure selection tool (checkboxes)

Before 'authorizing' your CPC+ practice, verify:

When authorization opens ...

An organization enrolled in QSS will see all of the authorization features for the CPC+ practice when authorization opens on Friday January 11, 2019

- 1. The 'Authorize CPC+' button will display in the CPC+ practice banner
- 2. Information button provides helpful guidance
- 3. Blue checkmark indicates the quality category is selected for authorization



Member or Clinical Admin roles required for authorization



CPC+ Authorization Warnings and Restrictions

At the point of authorization, warning or restriction messages will display to alert users of potential issues with the authorization.

- 1. CPC+ Practice Name & Practice ID
- 2. Warnings / Restrictions
 - Warning: authorization is not restricted; Recommended that warnings are reviewed.
 - **Restrictions**: Errors must be corrected in order to proceed with authorization.
- 3. Message with directions to resolve the issue
- 4. Authorization button is inactive for any restriction
- 5. Search feature
- 6. List may be downloaded as a CSV file
- 7. Column headers may be sorted ascending or descending

1. Confirm quality measures and results. Then select the 'Authorize CPC+' button.

CPC+ System Bookmarks

- A system generated bookmark is automatically created for each CPC+ practice that is authorized.
- The bookmark includes drill down to patient level data and is available for potential CMS audits.
- System created bookmarks cannot be edited or deleted.
- System created bookmarks end with (QSS) so they are easily distinguished from manually created bookmarks.

QSS Submission Confirmation

The MIPS and CPC+ Submission Confirmation feature provides key submission information in a single convenient location in the MQIC tab for those QSS participants whose data is submitted to CMS by Virence. This feature replaces the submission confirmation email.

Managing Authorization

- Return the QSS order
- Complete all pre-work prior to authorization
- Validate all clinician information before authorization including: Clinician NPI
 - Clinicians included in the CPC+ practice
- Verify CPC+ Practice Name, Practice ID, TIN
- Add CPC+ site address
- Verify report range calculated is January 1 December 31, 2018.
- Review the quality measure selection & results
 - Two outcome measures
 - At least seven of the remaining measures
- Be mindful of program timelines
- Remember that authorization is final.

- When the CPC+ practice is created, charges are incurred, regardless of submission.
- CPC+ Practice fee is assessed for the build, configuration, on-demand calculation and submission. Fees still apply for members that choose to attest or self submit their QRDA to CMS.
- Based on the number of clinicians in the CPC+ practice.
