GE Engineering noted system performance slowness validated at customer sites with upgrades of .Net from 4.5.2 to 4.7

Description of Issue: Seven elements of the CCDA 1.1 that CMS requires to be included for Meaningful Use and MIPS (if they are known to the provider) are not included in the Transition of Care (ToC) document if these data elements are not updated during the encounter preceding generation of the CCDA. The 7 elements are 1) Immunizations; 2) Care Plan; 3) Procedures; 4) Reason for Referral; 5) Vital Signs; 6) Encounter Diagnosis; and 7) Primary Care Physician (PCP) if the PCP does not contribute to the document.

CPS & CEMR: CMS 50 Quality Reporting CQM Measure

SPR 69484

Provides quality reporting credit for CMS 50 in CQR after linking the referral order and consult report to create the required SNOMED order code and date for the CONSULTATION observation

Once the order is completed and linked, the script pushes the change in the next CQR data run

CPS & CEMR: MU & ACI Quality Reporting

Resolves situation where Electronic Prescribing actions were not counting in the numerator as expected

Functional measure data on CQR Insight tab indicates prescription was not electronic when it was sent electronically SPR 70554

Prescribing method reverts to user's default SPR 70820

Detect for Problem:

Run the GE provided report or spot check for issue in the CQR insight dashboard

Ongoing Prevention:

Apply SP3 or CPS 12.3_ CEMR 9.12 or higher

CPS & CEMR: MU & ACI Quality Reporting

Resolves an issue preventing adding new data mappings, exclusions or reasons for meds not given

When an Observation term has an existing mapping with a result code, such as "patient declined", new mappings cannot be added for that term (SPR 69069)

Selecting to exclude a value from mapping does not record the exclusion (SPR 70270)

When an Observation term indicating a reason for not prescribing a medication is mapped to a drug within a CQM's value set, the reason is not sent to CQR (SPR 70227)

CPS Only Billing: Bulk Payment Posting

SPR 70766

Resolves an erroneous payer name when

A Bulk Insurance Payment is posted in Payment Entry and applied to multiple visits with patient deposits

The system saves and applies the first visit's patient name from the bulk payment to all visits with patient deposits when reconciling. This results in incorrect payer names displaying in the visit transactions and on statements.

Detect for Problem:

Repair impacted visits using release notes steps

Ongoing Prevention:

Apply SP3 or CPS 12.3 or higher
