



CPS 12.3 Prescription Highlights

Summary

The prescription refill workflow changed in CPS 12.2 and CEMR 9.10 and continues to evolve in CPS 12.3 and CEMR 9.12.

These changes will enhance care quality, increase provider efficiency, and reduce the time it takes to manage prescriptions.

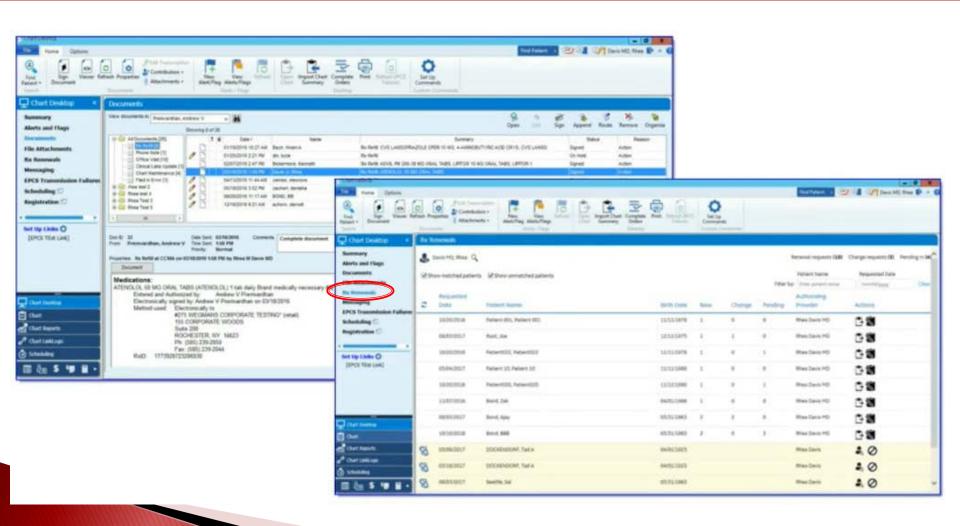


Rx Renewal Changes

- 1) Unmatched patients are worked in Rx Renewal tab rather than in LinkLogic.
- 2) All requested medications will be in one document.
- 3) Delegates have the opportunity to ensure refill is appropriate prior to document being routed to the provider's Desktop.



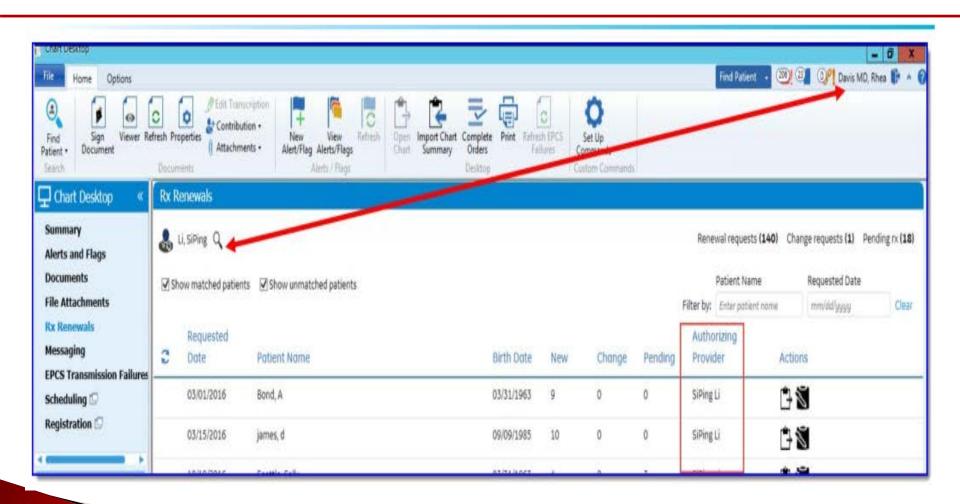
Rx Renewals Section of Desktop

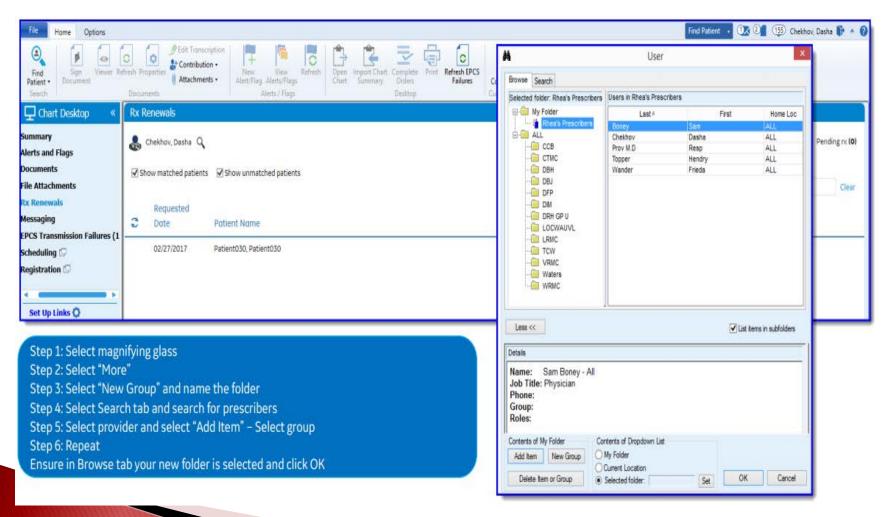

eSM verifies and sends to LinkLogic to match. *Unmatched patients are worked in LinkLogic*

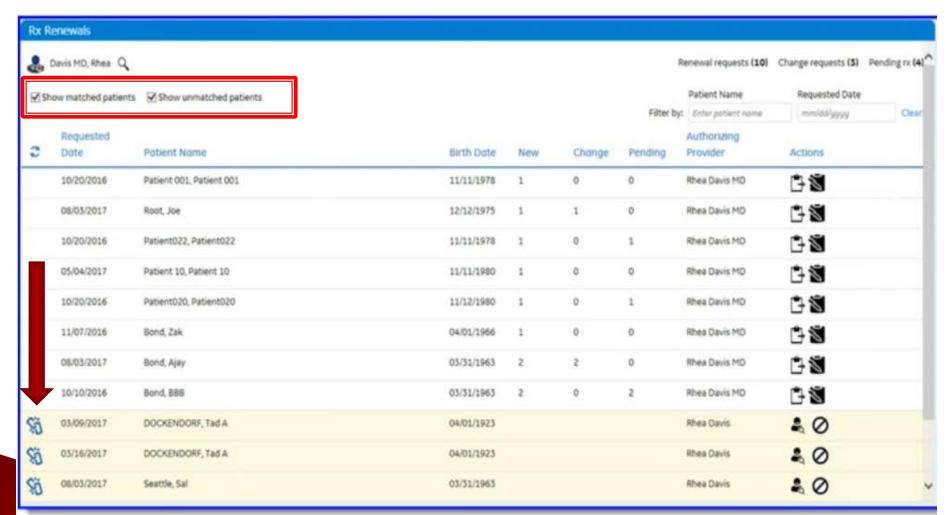
CPS 12.3

Rx Renewal Workflow Changes – Unmatched Patients

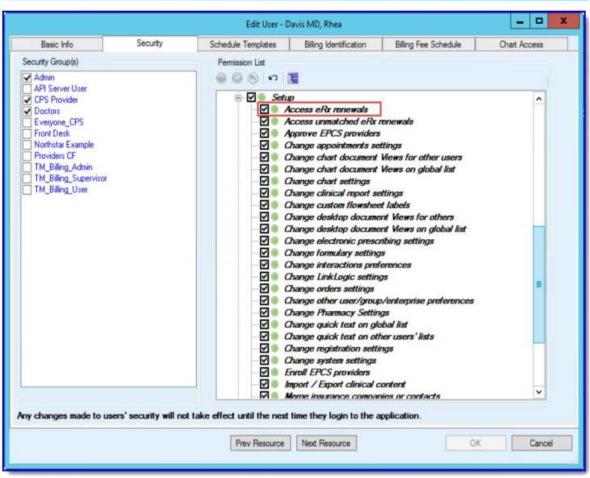




Security Settings To View Rx Renewals

Administration>Application Users> User Management> User> Security> Setup> Access eRx renewals

 Any user addressing prescription refills needs access to "Access eRx renewals".

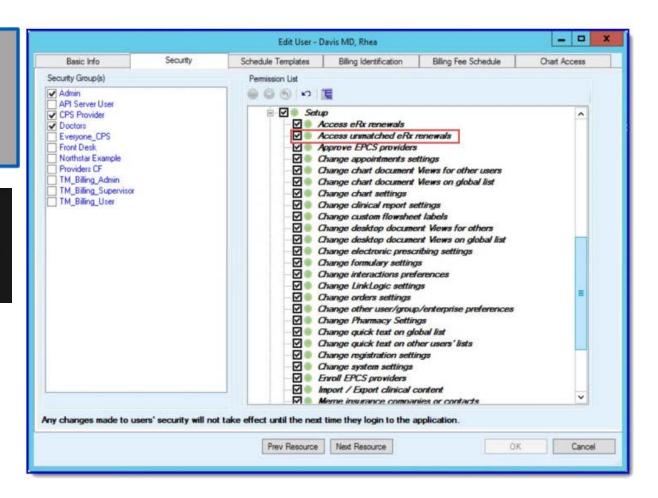




Security Settings to View Unmatched Patients

Administration>Application Users> User Management> User> Security> Setup> Access unmatched eRx renewals

If providers do not need to work "unmatched" patients, simply do not grant the security permission.

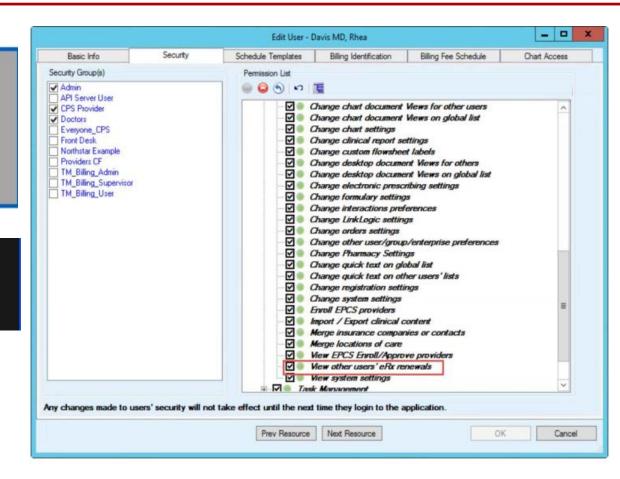




Security Settings To View Other Users Rx Renewals

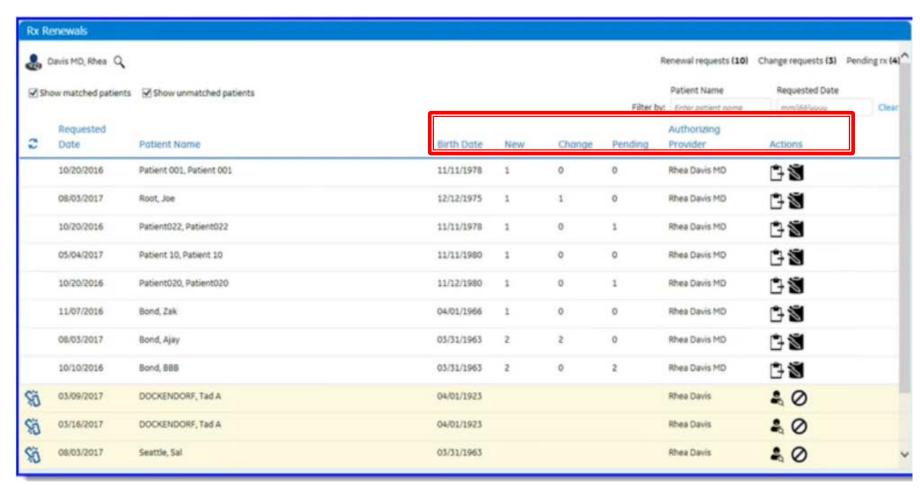
Administration>Application Users> User Management> User> Security> Setup> View other users' eRx renewals

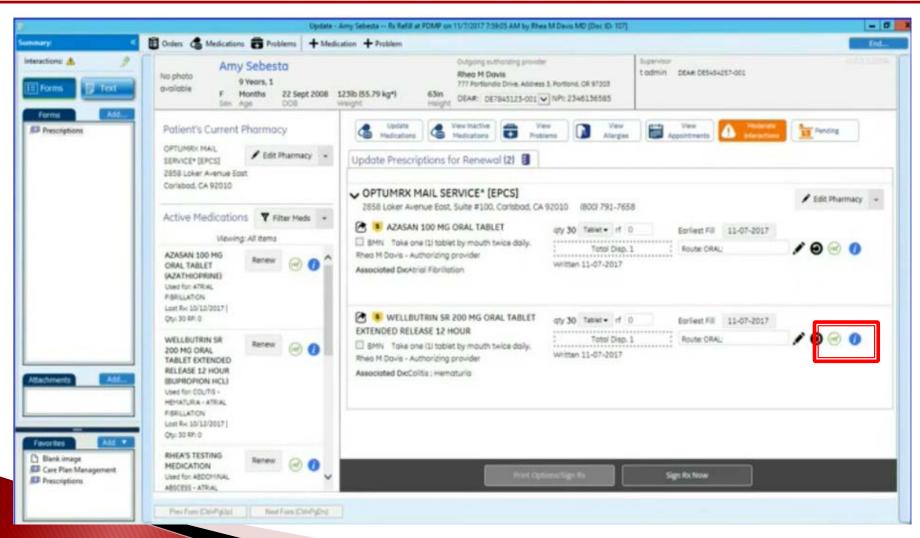
White icon opens chart

Rx Renewal Workflow Changes

- Requested Date has not changed
- Birth Date is now visible
- New = how many electronic Rx Refills are coming in for the patient; these can now be addressed in one document.
- Pending = there is a document already started with a medication that hasn't been addressed yet. This could be a document with a Refill or a refill within an office visit.
- Change = new for 12.3. This is a Pharmacy communicating with a practice without picking up the phone.
- A Change request could be due to:
- Drug Change (formulary compliance, day's supply, prescription clarification)
- Generic substitution
- Prior Authorization

Prescription Workflow Changes

Electronic Prescribing - 45 CFR 170.315(b)(3) - MU 3

(i) Enable a user to perform all of the following prescription-related electronic transactions in accordance with the standard specified in § 170.205(b)(2) and, at a minimum, the version of the standard specified in § 170.207(d)(3) as follows:

- (A)Create new prescriptions (NEWRX).
- (B) Change prescriptions (RXCHG, CHGRES).
- (C) Cancel prescriptions (CANRX, CANRES).
- (D)Refill prescriptions (REFREQ, REFRES).
- (E) Receive fill status notifications (RXFILL).
- (F) Request and receive medication history information (RXHREQ, RXHRES).

The items in red are new requirements for Quality Reporting

Change/Cancel/Fill Status

Change

Change could be due to Drug Change (formulary compliance, days' supply, prescription clarification), generic substitution, or prior authorization.

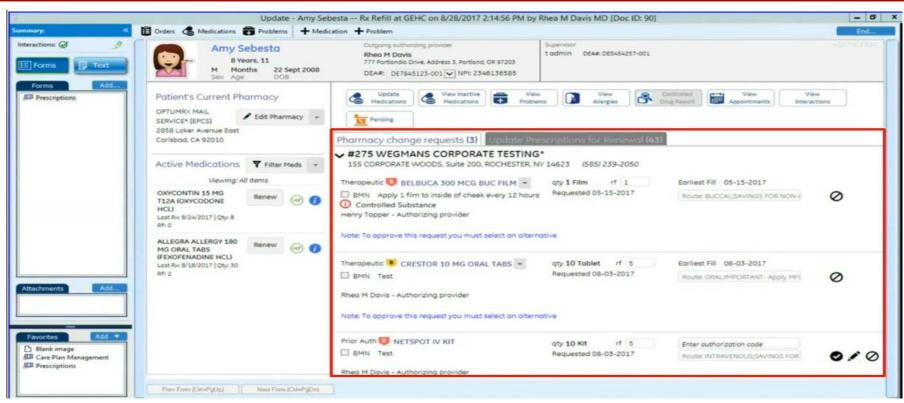
Cancel

This follows the normal 'remove medication' workflow. The pharmacy will receive a 'cancel' request.

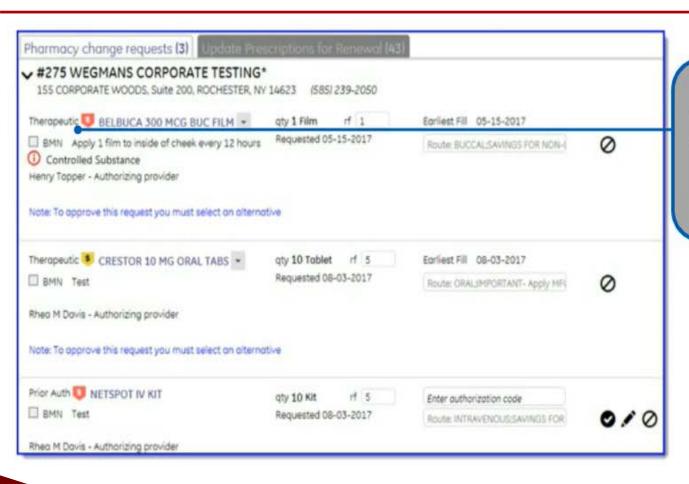
Fill Status

Centricity is ready to handle this, but Pharmacies are not yet equipped for this.

Pharmacy Change Requests



- New tab at top, 'Pharmacy change requests'
- Cannot address Prescriptions for Renewal until the Pharmacy change requests are addressed



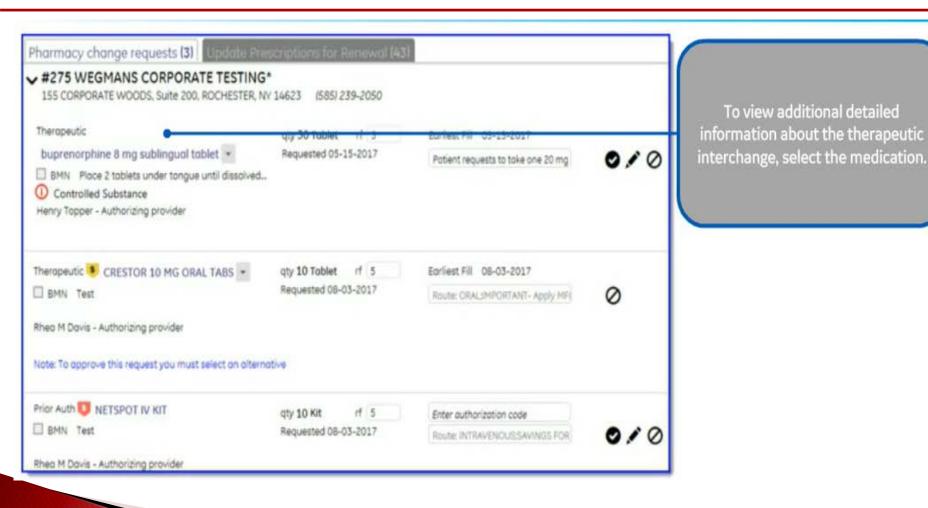
Reason for medication change request. "Change" could be due to: drug change (formulary compliance, days' supply, prescription clarification), generic substitution, or prior authorization.

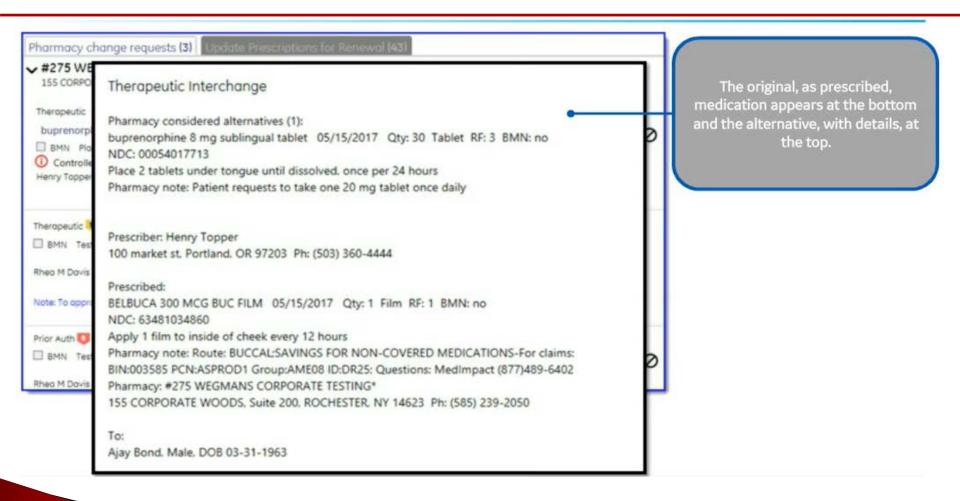


Original medication shows and only has one icon on the right.

To view/select pharmacy suggested alternative, utilize dropdown.

Select the changed medication.







Once approved, the medication will move from the "Pharmacy change requests" tab to the "Update Prescriptions for Renewal" tab



Opens up familiar Edit Prescription dialog box. Will then move to "Update Prescriptions..." tab.

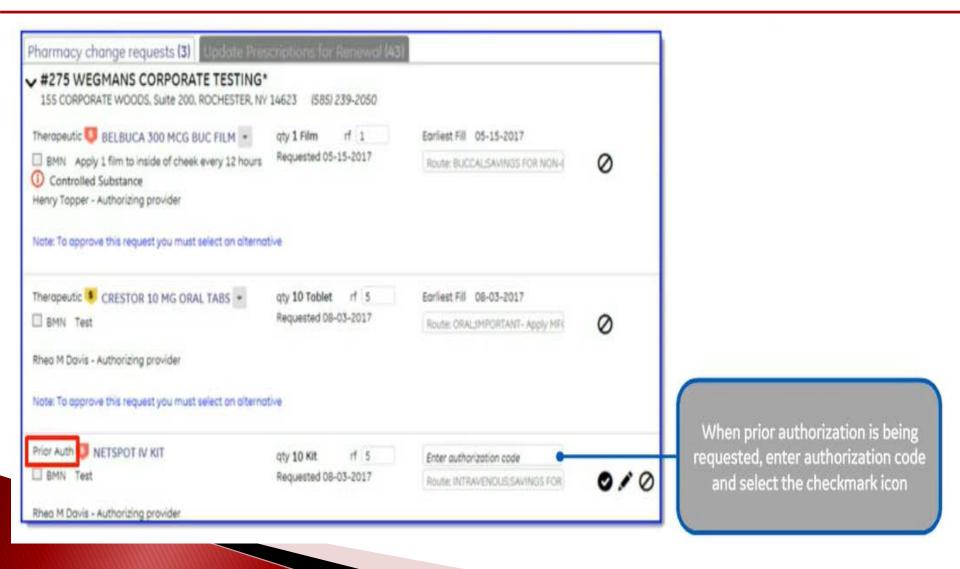


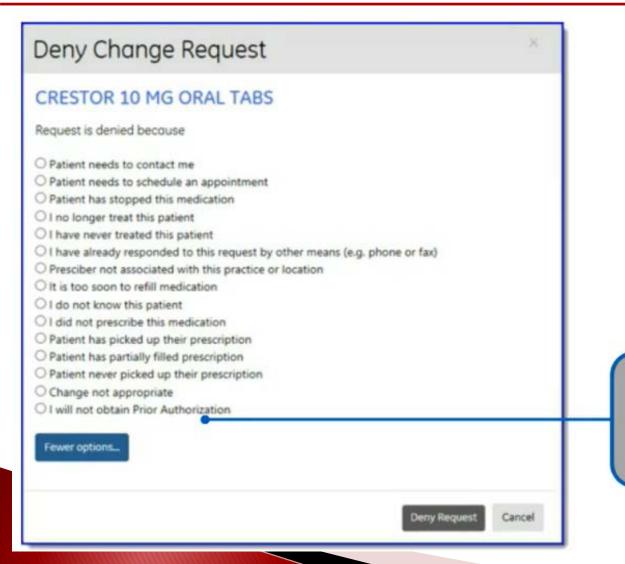
Requires user to select a denial reason.

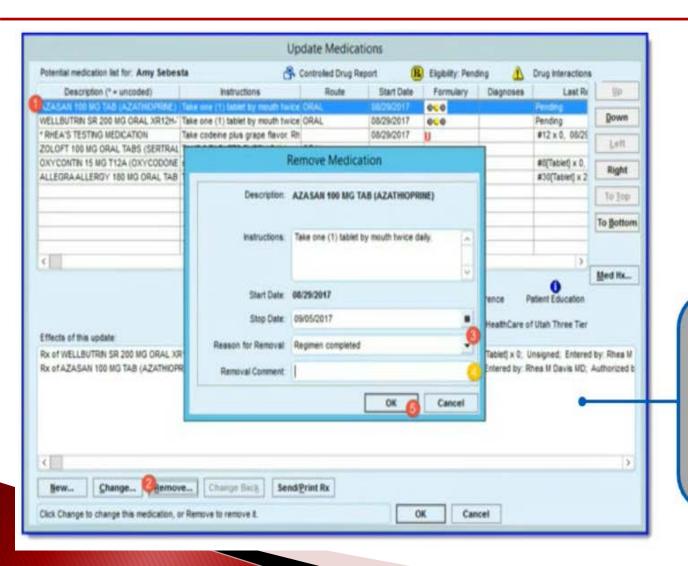






When denying a Prior Authorization, note this is a denial option.

Cancel Request

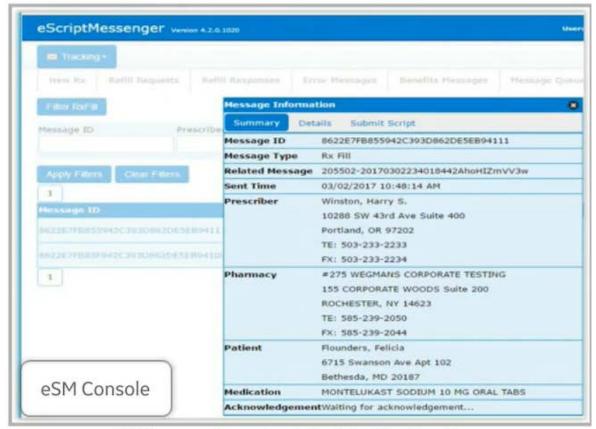


To send notification of removing a medication from the patient's active medication list, follow normal remove medication workflow. The pharmacy associated with the prescription will get a "cancel" request.

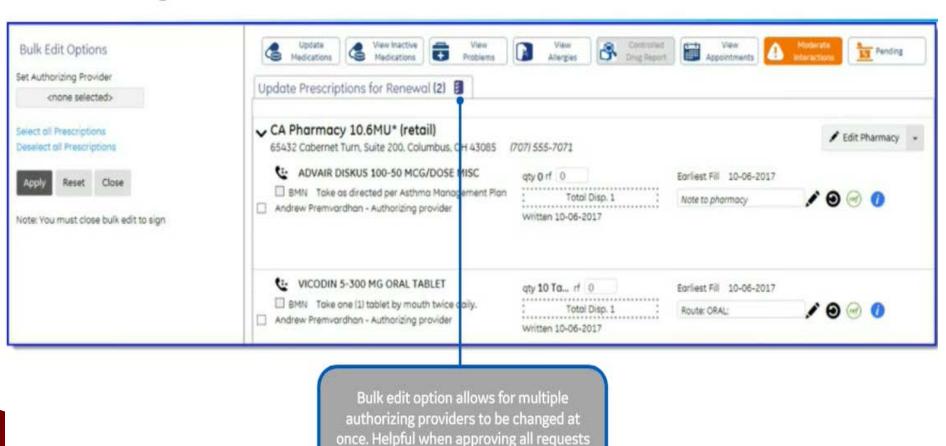

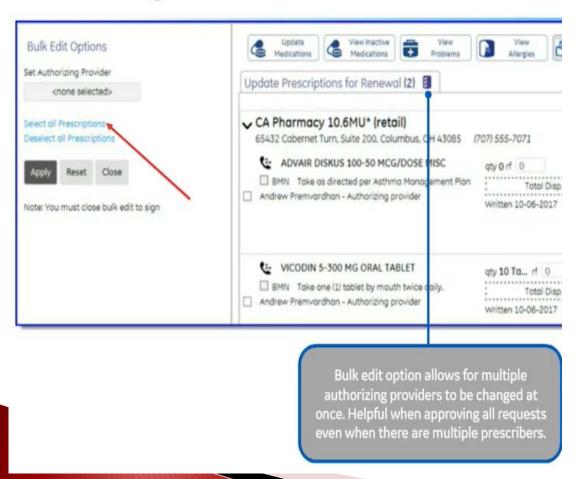

Medication Coupons & Alerts

Medication discount information and alerts are now available for printed and electronic prescriptions. When a medication with a discount is prescribed, that information is automatically printed with the prescription or is sent to the patient's pharmacy electronically within the pharmacy note for redemption.

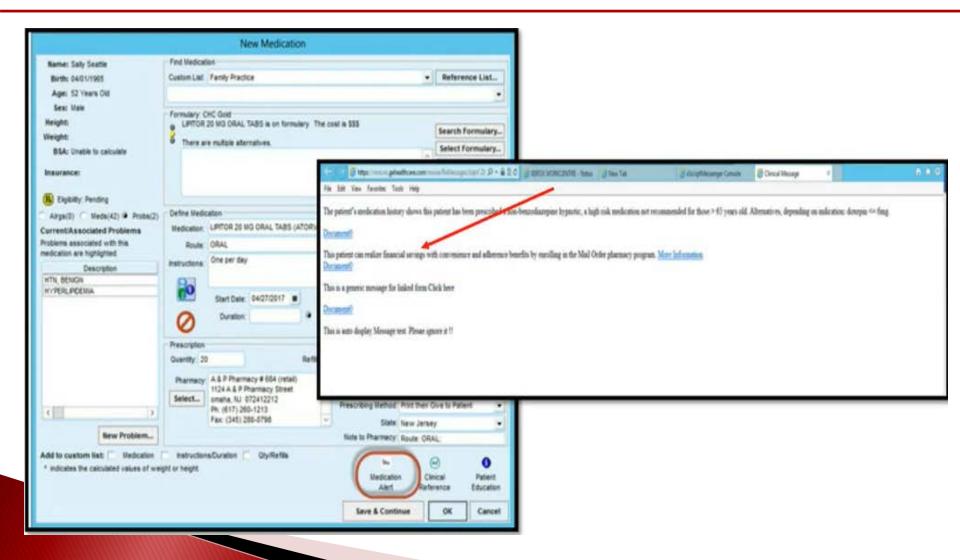

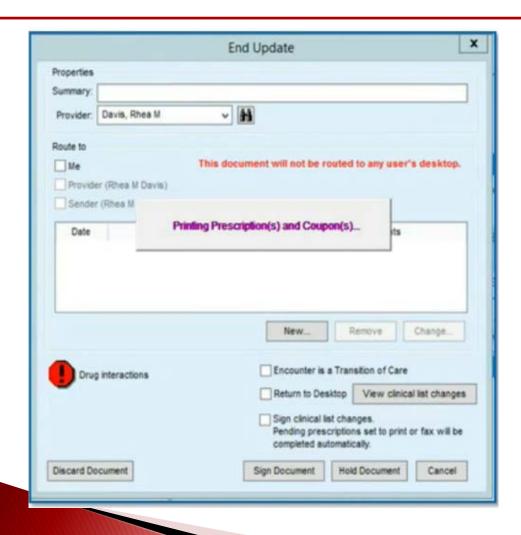

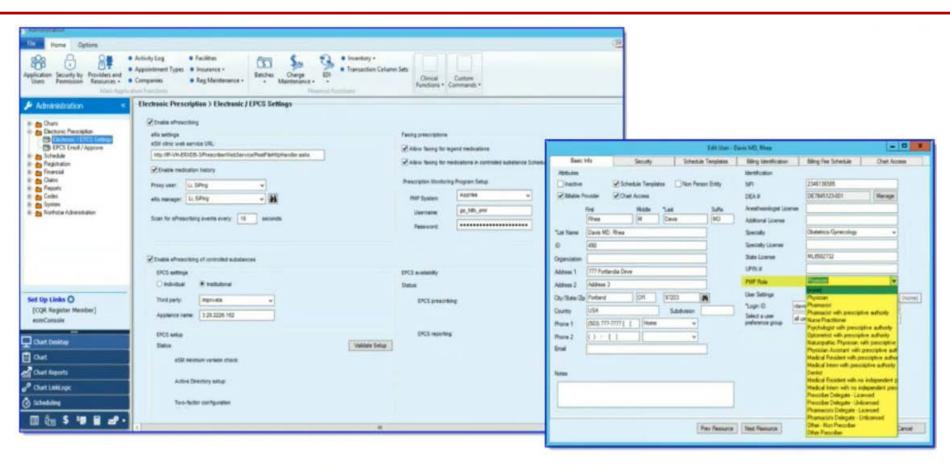
You will see "Printing Prescription(s) and Coupons whether there is a coupon or not.

Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP OR PMP)

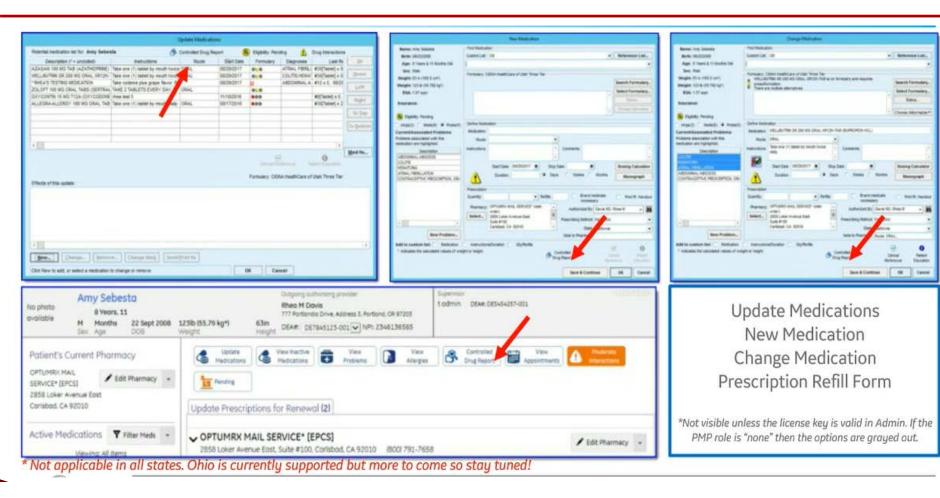
- New in CPS 12.3
- States are in the process of implementing this program to combat prescription drug abuse.
- It will allow a prescriber to see what their patients are picking up at the pharmacy that they did not prescribe.
- This information is available whether the patient pays cash or goes through insurance.
- Current Medication History functionality only returns what was purchased with insurance.
- This taps into a State-maintained database.

Upon upgrade, PMP role and setup area will be present in Administration whether you have PDMP enabled or not.

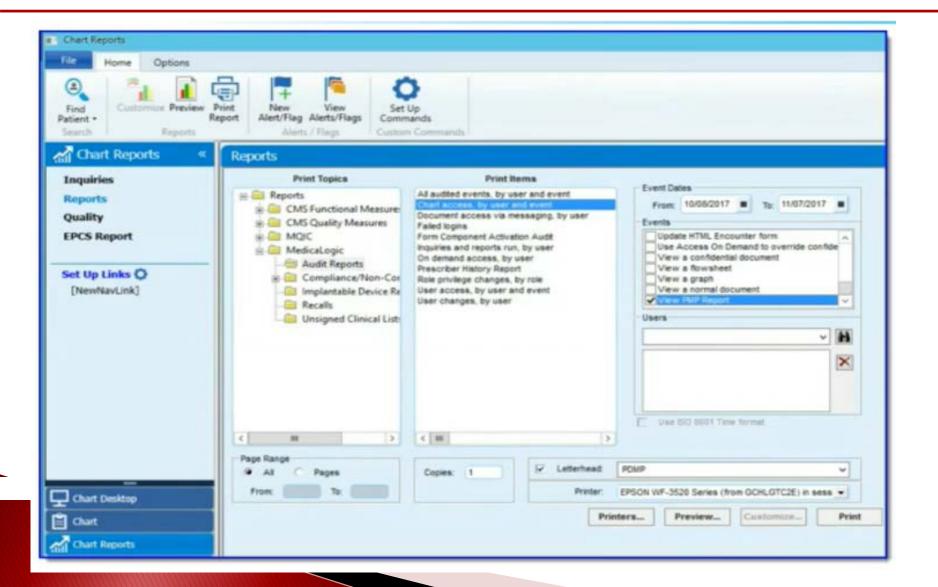
Reporting includes:

Date of fill, the drug product and strength, the quantity dispensed, the anticipated number of days the prescription should last, the prescriber, the dispensing pharmacy, and the method of payment (including cash transactions).

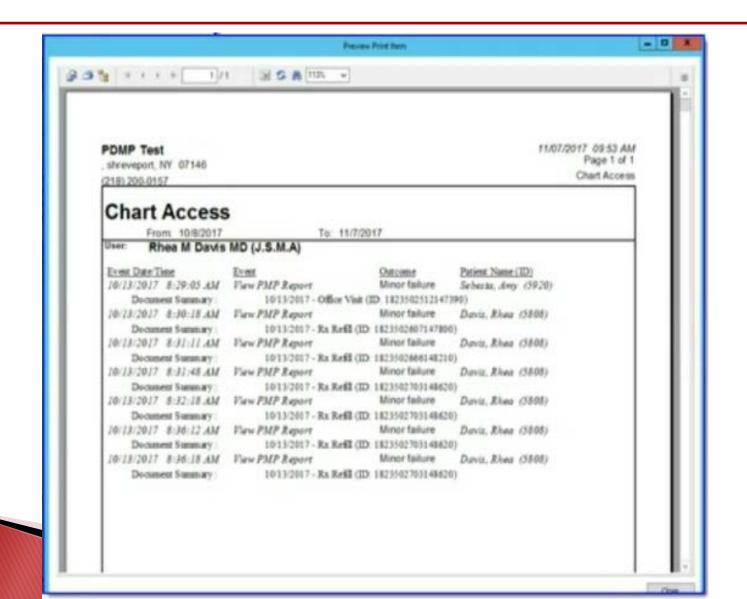
The default Rx lookup history is 2 years.
